- The Institute wil not be responsible for loss of valuables / cash brought by the students to the campus.










positive impression on the students, inspiring a collective commitment to creating a safe and respectful environment for all.




As a symbol of awareness, cloth bags were gifted to the students and faculty members of MBA@HCMR.

3rd final round - 1 winner team was selected.






The selection in the rounds was based on their team work, co-ordination, stratergies and their performance of kite flying.
