JEHANGIR RATANJI DADABHOY TATA (29 JULY 1904 – 29 NOVEMBER 1993) WAS A FRENCH-INDIAN AVIATOR, INDUSTRIALIST, ENTREPRENEUR AND CHAIRMAN OF TATA GROUP.

BORN INTO THE TATA FAMILY OF INDIA, HE WAS THE SON OF NOTED BUSINESSMAN RATANJI DADABHOY TATA AND HIS WIFE SUZANNE BRIÈRE. HIS MOTHER WAS THE FIRST WOMAN IN INDIA TO DRIVE A CAR AND, IN 1929, HE BECAME THE FIRST LICENSED PILOT IN INDIA. HE IS ALSO BEST KNOWN FOR BEING THE FOUNDER OF SEVERAL INDUSTRIES UNDER THE TATA GROUP, INCLUDING TATA CONSULTANCY SERVICES, TATA MOTORS, TITAN INDUSTRIES, TATA SALT, VOLTAS AND AIR INDIA. IN 1983, HE WAS AWARDED THE FRENCH LEGION OF HONOUR AND IN 1955 AND 1992, HE RECEIVED TWO OF INDIA'S HIGHEST CIVILIAN AWARDS THE PADMA VIBHUSHAN AND THE BHARAT RATNA. THESE HONOURS WERE BESTOWED ON HIM FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO INDIAN INDUSTRY.


CHALLENGES IN COVID

- Commenting on the impact of the pandemic, he said the global health crisis resulted in muted consumer demand along with disruption in the production supply chain and retail networks.
- Tata Motors lost 91 people from its ecosystem due to COVID-19 and it "will do everything" it can to support their families, company Chairman N Chandrasekaran said on Friday. Even after enduring "the fiscal year 2021" which has been "amongst the most challenging to date", the company is on track to become a zero-debt company by the financial year 2023-24, he said while addressing shareholders in the company's annual general meeting held virtually.
