- 1. Title of the Activity:** Workshop on Interview Process - Profit & Loss and Time & Work
- 2. Date & Venue:** 4/10/2024. MBA@IICMR had organized its Employability Enhancement Program (EEP) 2024 for Second year MBA Students.

3. Outcomes of Activity:

- Description of the Study:**

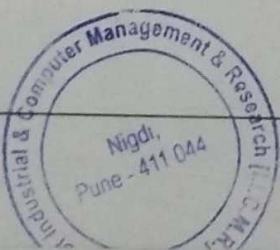
Time & Work:

The trainer covered various aspects of time and work problems, including the relationship between work, time, and efficiency. Key topics included calculating individual and combined work rates, determining the time taken for multiple people to complete a task, and understanding the concept of inverse proportionality between time and workforce. Techniques for managing these calculations quickly and accurately were shared.

Practical Problem-Solving:

Mr. Athavale emphasized real-world applications of these concepts, helping students understand their importance in business scenarios. He provided tips on approaching

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questions logically and managing time effectively during exams.

Shortcuts and Efficiency Techniques:

Students were introduced to useful shortcuts for solving profit and loss as well as time and work questions, allowing them to work faster and enhance their test-taking efficiency. The session included multiple practice problems and examples, with students participating in hands-on exercises. Mr. Athavale provided personalized feedback and guidance to help each student improve.
